CCPS Closes Food Service Operations at PSES for Routine Cleaning

JONESBORO – In an effort to ensure the health and safety of our students, their families and our employees, the School Nutrition Department of Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) has closed the food service operation at Pointe South Elementary School (PSES) in Riverdale for Monday-Tuesday, January 11-12, 2021. The decision to shut down the PSES operation was prompted by the need for this facility to undergo routine cleaning.

Family members who have been picking up meals curbside at Pointe South Elementary go to the closest neighboring school in their community. The routes/meal stops associated with this school will not be serviced. Those using drop-off services should also go to the closest neighboring school in their community.

It is anticipated that meal service will resume at Pointe South Elementary on Wednesday, January 13. Drop-off services will resume at this school on this specified date. The district apologizes for any inconvenience this action may cause.
